Cosmetic lip repositioning

A smile can often be a person's most striking feature but it needs to be wielded with confidence. Many people have smiles that expose great teeth but too much of their gums, which can make them self-conscious and reluctant to smile as often as they should. However, removing a small amount of tissue from the inside of the upper lip can reduce excessive and unattractive gum display. A lip repositioning procedure can give the patient a more balanced, aesthetically pleasing smile.

While in the US, Dr Nettle trained at the same clinic in Beverly Hills where the lip repositioning technique was pioneered by periodontists Ari Rosenblatt and Ziv Simon. The two have also acted as consultants Extreme Makeover.

Hairline lowering

While in the States, Dr Nettle also trained in hairline lowering with leading hair restoration and facial plastic surgeon Dr Sheldon Kabaker in San Francisco. Dr Kabaker is often referred to as the guru of hairline lowering. The procedure is particularly suitable for women with high hairlines, which can occur naturally or may be the result of forehead-lift procedures.

The ageing process can also take a toll on a woman's hair, resulting in a gradual loss of hair and a higher hairline. This can not only have an effect on the overall appearance of the face, but can also affect confidence levels and self-esteem. A high hairline may lend an aged and somewhat masculine appearance to some women, while lowering it can create a more harmonious relationship between the hair and the face, resulting in a softer, more feminine appearance.

After his experience in the US, Dr Nettle is confident these new procedures can offer excellent and easily achievable results for people seeking new confidence in their smiles and more flattering frames for their faces. acsm
